


CASE 3

14 yrs old girl presenting with swelling of elbow for 1 yr; now mild pain and restriction of movement



SYNOVIAL HAEMANGIOMA

- Benign vascular lesion arising from any structure lined by synovium including the intra-articular region, bursal spaces and tendon sheaths.
- Typically present in children and young adults.
- It is most commonly located in the knee, but it has also been reported in other joints including the elbow, ankle and wrist
- Occasionally patients can have recurrent haemarthroses.
