



- The dens is related to many critical neurovascular structures, and pathologies involving the dens can lead to significant morbidity, and potentially mortality
- Tumours of the odontoid peg are rare
- Due to their scarcity, their diagnosis and management can be delayed
- Pathological anomalies can be congenital, degenerative, inflammatory, traumatic or neoplastic in nature
- Spinal surgeons and Radiologists need to be aware of such lesions to initiate appropriate early diagnosis and management
