





MR Imaging in Idiopathic Inflammatory Myopathies.

- ❖ Diagnosis: MRI can identify active muscle inflammation. There is some evidence that quantitative MRI tools may be able to detect disease that can be missed in routine studies
- ❖ Useful in monitoring disease both visually and in terms of muscle volume, fat fraction and T2, in distinguishing active muscle inflammation, from mild, low and no inflammation.
- ❖ Biopsy remains the primary criteria of diagnosis as per ENMC revised criteria 2023.
